

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE SIGNING OF A
FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND
OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

On December 23, 1992 the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA); the United States Environmental Protection Agency Region 9; the California Department of Toxic Substances Control, and the City Regional Water Quality Control Board signed a federal facilities agreement for environmental cleanup activities at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) in Pasadena.

The joint agreement provides a procedural framework for developing, implementing and monitoring appropriate cleanup activities at JPL and ensures cooperation and full participation by the parties involved.

The federal facilities agreement will be available for review during a 45 day public comment period beginning January 7, 1993 and ending February 22, 1993.
