Summary and Action Items:

Operable Unit 3 Update

- Lincoln Avenue Water Company (LAWC) System:
 - Bob Hayward was unable to attend meeting; although, he indicated that everything was running smoothly during a telephone conversation with Steve Slaten.
 - The last batch of resin from Siemens lasted 3 months longer than expected. LAWC has now fully transitioned to the new resin, CalRes 2109, and LAWC seems to be satisfied with their new contract with Calgon Carbon.
 - Keith Fields noted that the annual operational summary technical memorandum will be submitted next week.
 - **Action Item:** NASA to ensure that Christine Borja and Tony Zampiello are on the distribution list for the LAWC Technical Memorandum.
 - **Action Item:** NASA to organize a meeting between LAWC and PWP (prior to startup of the City of Pasadena treatment system) to discuss operational lessons-learned.
- City of Pasadena System:
 - Discussed status of the Conditional Use Permit (CUP) Process. PWP submitted the CUP package on March 20, 2008 and the public hearing is scheduled for July 10, 2008.

- An informational meeting for Windsor Site neighbors is being planned prior to the public hearing, scheduled for June 18, 2008.
 - Alan Sorsher is reviewing the most recent documentation associated
 - **Action Item:** Gary Takara to provide RBMB with details of the planned utility water discharge to the spreading basin.
 - **Action Item:** Nina Jazmadarian to provide draft revisions to the RWQCB general waste discharge permit to Keith Fields. This permit is associated with surface water discharges for drinking water treatment systems.
- Sunset Wells Update:
 - Gary Takara reported on Sunset Wells and PWP Eastside Wells.
 - Perchlorate levels have been consistent over the last 6 to 9 months.
 - Villa Well offline and being repaired.
 - Monte Vista Well is offline, although PWP is still collecting samples.
 - PWP has received the draft report from Geoscience Support Services evaluating elevated levels of VOC in Copelin Well.
 - Discussed Prop 50 funding for the proposed Sunset treatment system. Jeff O'Keefe indicated that funding is still on track.
 - **Action Item:** Gary Takara to provide a copy of the draft Geoscience report to NASA.
 - Additional Investigation Update:
 - NASA waiting on comments from DTSC and RWQCB.

Public Involvement Update:

- Merrilee Fellows reported on the community involvement activities related to the JPL cleanup program:
- The JPL Open House will be held May 3 and 4. NASA will host a booth with displays on the Cleanup Program.
- Preparing an updated fact sheet associated with the proposed MHTS.
- Noted that JPL was the recipient of a 2008 NASA Blue Marble Award for **Excellence in Energy and Water Management**

OU-1 Update:

- The OU-1 system has been running at design capacity (300 gpm) since January.
- Submitted the Semi-Annual Progress Technical Memorandum on April 10, 2008.

Other Items:

- Groundwater Monitoring
 - Submitted the 4th Quarter 2007 Groundwater Monitoring Technical Memorandum on March 11, 2008.
 - Completed the 1st Quarter 2008 Groundwater Monitoring field activities February 14. The Technical Memorandum will be submitted in May 2008.
 - Initiated the 2nd Quarter 2008 Groundwater Monitoring on April 21.

- OU-2 Well Abandonment
 - Currently on hold while NASA evaluates comments from DTSC.
 - **Action Item:** Battelle to send RBMB a copy of the OU-2 Well Abandonment work plan.
